Scrutton Close (self-contained flats).

Medium level support will be offered but residents will also have the opportunity to pay for "hotel services" such as cooked meals in a communal dining room, flat cleaning and a laundry service.

People who need domiciliary care will be referred for assessment and care will be available from either outside or in house providers.

SERVICE

Response Longer Term Housing provides places for adults and older adults with enduring mental health needs. The accommodation is based over three sites in Oxford.

SUPPORT

Our dedicated staff team are skilled in providing support on an individualised basis, which is crucial for a resident group with long term needs.

Care services can be provided, if needs require, through the provision of personal budgets and assessment.

RECOVERY

The staff work using the recovery approach to ensure an individualised service is provided and goals are achieved and maintained.

AIMS

We aim to provide good quality services and promotion of mental health with the involvement of residents. We strive to maintain a dignified and compassionate approach to working with residents with long term needs ensuring a person centred approach is used at all times, often with multi-disciplinary teams.

ACCESS

A referral can be made through the 'One Front Door' referral process for the Mind Response Housing Partnership. This is a single point of contact for referrals and assessments to simplify and streamline access to our services.
