THESE ARE SHORT-TERM SERVICES OFFERING ACCOMMODATION BASED SUPPORT IN THE CITY AND THROUGHOUT OXFORDSHIRE.

Accommodation is provided in various settings i.e. large and small shared houses and self-contained flats. The support will promote recovery with the aim of helping people to move on within two years to independent housing.

Sixty places are currently available in various locations in Oxford City and sixty places will be available in the county. County places are currently located in Bicester, Cholsey and Witney, with other places planned for Abingdon, Banbury, and Didcot.

SHORT-TERM SUPPORTED
HOUSING IN THE COMMUNITY



SERVICE

The Mind Response Transitional Housing services provide short term supported accommodation - up to two years - for those people in Oxford City and throughout Oxfordshire, who have serious and/or enduring mental health needs.

SUPPORT

Our dedicated staff team work Monday to Friday 9.30am to 5.30pm with flexibility to work outside these times to provide support on a pre-arranged basis. There is also a telephone on call service for residents in an emergency out of hours.

RECOVERY

The staff work using the recovery approach to provide individually tailored support based on each residents' needs, to promote positive change and develop their own wellbeing and build on social networks.

AIMS

We strive to promote good mental health through the provision of high quality service with residents involvement. We aim to work proactively with residents to provide support needed to move on into independent housing.

We provide resettlement support for up to four weeks and also link residents in with floating support in a planned way if appropriate.

ACCESS

A referral can be made through the 'One Front Door' referral process for the Mind Response Housing Partnership. This is a single point of contact for referrals and assessments to simplify and streamline access to our services.
